

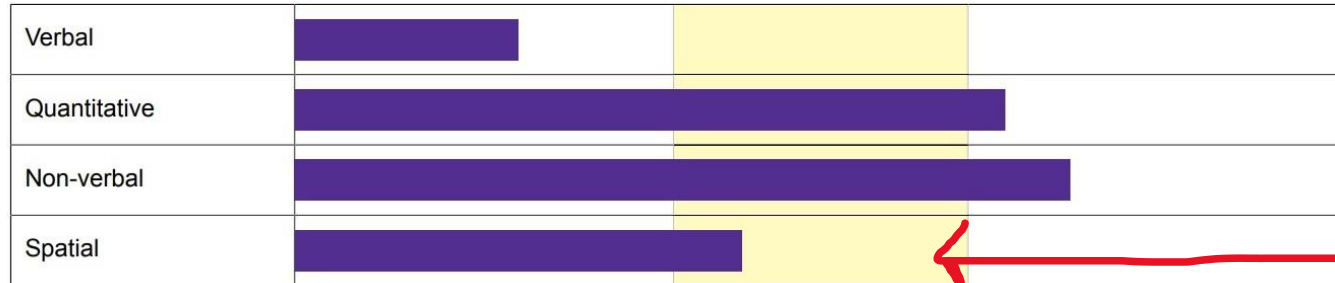

- should use online resources, videos and books with plenty of pictures to help remember key facts and information.
- may find much of his schoolwork difficult.
- Does find reading and maths difficult? If so, he may need some extra help working at home under guidance from school.
- When you are helping with homework, make sure that understands each step of the task before moving on. It is important that learns at a pace that is right for him.
- Tell to ask the teacher to explain anything that is not clear.

If they are good at Maths, try Business, Music, Science

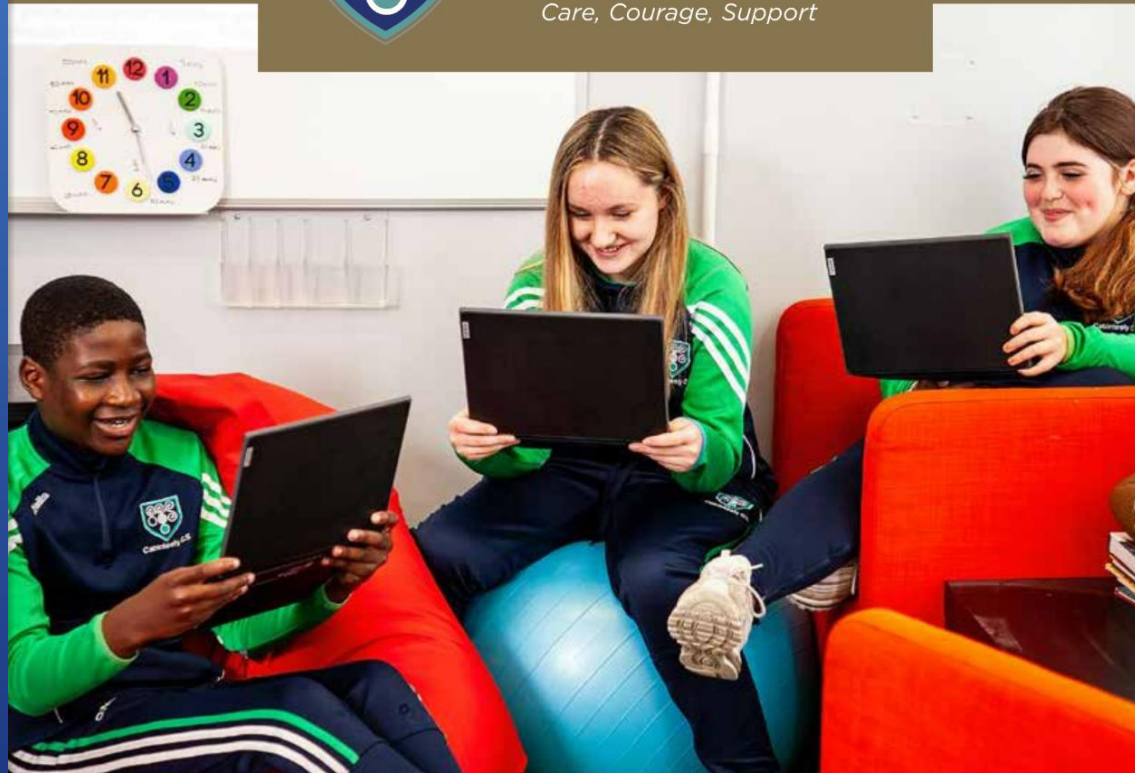
If they like reading, they might try Home Economics, Business, Science


